Frosted Forest Reindeer Card



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Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Frosted Forest Bundle (164137); Reindeer Fun Bundle (English) [164044],
- Card Stock Cherr Cobbler [119685], Smoky Slate [131202], Basic White [159276], Basic Black [121045], Garden Green [102584], Real [102482],
- Stamp Pads: Jet Black Stāzon Ink Pad [101406], Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad [132708], Crumb Cake [147116], Basic Beige [163806], Pretty In Pink [163807], Shaded Spruce [147088], Mossy Meadow [147111], Pool Party [147107], Smoky Slate [147113], Night Of Navy Pad [147110], Versamark Pad [102283]
- Misc: Basics Wow! Embossing Powder [165679], Heat Tool [129053], Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine [149653], Clear Block Bundle [165674], Blending Brushes [153611], Small Blending Brushes [160518], Water Painters [151298], Iridescent Pearl Basic Jewels [158987], Real Red Stampin' Blends Combo Pack [154899], Mini Glue Dots [103683], Multipurpose Liquid Glue [110755], Stampin' Dimensionals [104430], Embossing Paste [141979], Rhinestone Basic Jewels [144220]

Measurements:

Smoky Slate: 5 ½" x 8 ½" (scored at 4 ¼")

Cherry Cobbler: 4" x 5 ¼"
Basic White: 4" x 5 ¼"

Garden Green: for holly die cuts

Real Red: for berry die cut

Basic Black: scrap strip for sentiment

Instructions:

- 1. Start with your **Smoky Slate** card base, fold along the score line to create your card.
- 2. Glue the Cherry Cobbler cardstock onto the card base.
- 3. Using the **Reindeer Fun Bundle**, die cut the deer from a scrap piece of paper to use as a mask later. Set aside.
- 4. On the **Basic White** card stock, stamp the deer image using **Black Stazon Ink**.
- 5. Color the deer using a **Water Painter** and the following inks: **Crumb Cake**, **Basic Beige**, **Pecan Pie**, and **Pretty in Pink** for the ears and cheeks.
- 6. Place the mask of the deer over your colored image to protect it while working on the background.
- 7. Using **Black Memento Ink**, stamp trees from the **Frosted Forest Stamp Set** around the deer image.
- 8. With **Decorative Masks**, start blending the background:
 - Mask No. 1: Use a Blender Brush to sponge on Shaded Spruce Ink.
 - Mask No. 2: Sponge with Mossy Meadow Ink.
 - Mask No. 3: Sponge again with Mossy Meadow Ink.
- 9. Apply **Versamark Ink** over the trees using a **Sponge Dauber** with **Mask No. 1**. Heat emboss the trees with **White Embossing Powder**.
- 10. Place the negative image of the deer die cut over the stamped deer, cover with **Versamark Ink**, and heat emboss with **Clear Embossing Powder**.
- 11. Lightly blend around the trees using **Blending Brushes** with **Smoky Slate**, **Pool Party**, and **Night of Navy** ink pads to create a soft background.
- 12. Stamp snowflakes with **Pool Party Ink**, stamping off onto scrap paper first before stamping onto the card.
- 13. Cut the stamped **Basic White** layer using the Perennial Postage Die and glue the onto the **Cherry Cobbler** layer of the card base.
- 14. Die cut holly leaves from **Garden Green** cardstock using the dies from the **Reindeer Fun Bundle**. Run them through the **Painted Texture Embossing Folder** and adhere to the card with **liquid glue** and **Stampin' Dimensionals**.
- 15. Cut the berry dies from **Real Red** cardstock, and set aside.
- 16. Make a bow with **gold thread**, and adhere the holly leaves with **glue dots**.
- 17. Place the berry die cut on top of the bow using **glue dots**.
- 18. Color 3 pearls with the **Real Red Stampin' Blend Marker** and place them on the berries.
- 19. Add rhinestones around the card for extra sparkle.
- 20. Use **White Textured Paste** to create snow along the ground of the scene. Let dry.
- 21. For the sentiment, stamp with **Versamark Ink** onto a scrap strip of **Basic Black** cardstock, emboss with **White Embossing Powder**, trim, and adhere to the card with **Stampin' Dimensionals**.
- 22. Add Clear Wink of Stella to the holly leaves for some shimmer.
